We are so excited for what this new year will bring for our organization, and we hope that everyone who came got a glimpse of what is in store for 2024.

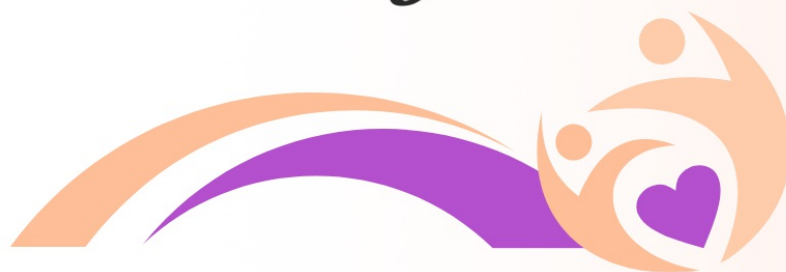
