In April 2018, Hanul moved to a beautiful new space in Buffalo Grove through its partnership with Vernon Township. This meant more programs for our seniors in Lake County like hot meals, exercise, mental health, and socialization activities. In Cook County, Hanul was able to acquire its Chicago office building through the Illinois Facility Funds' Real Estate Solutions Program. This office has served as Hanul's headquarters since 1998.

Hanul became a state licensed mental health counseling agency in May 2018 to help individuals that are in need of mental health assessment and counseling. In addition, Hanul has been a leading agency that provides caregiver support for families that care for their loved ones who suffer from all stages of dementia-related diseases. Hanul is also preparing to launch Memory Café, a new welcoming space for individuals with Alzheimer's or any type of dementia and brain disorder.

As the large baby boomer population ages and more people live longer, Hanul continues to serve seniors of diverse socioeconomic backgrounds with different needs at all three of our locations. Our Private Home Care service and Home Delivered Meal program allow seniors without Medicaid to feel safe and healthy in their own homes. Hanul also provides a space that is appealing to the new generation of older adults so that they can continue to be engaged as an active citizen.

A STORY FROM HANUL

Mrs. J was diagnosed with cervical cancer seven years ago. While receiving treatment, it became more difficult for her to take care of herself. Because of this, Mrs. J applied for home care service through Hanul. A private home care aide was able to provide assistance and have Korean meals delivered to her home five times a week. "I was home all by myself without any food or assistance until my son and husband came back from work. I couldn't have made it this far without Hanul."

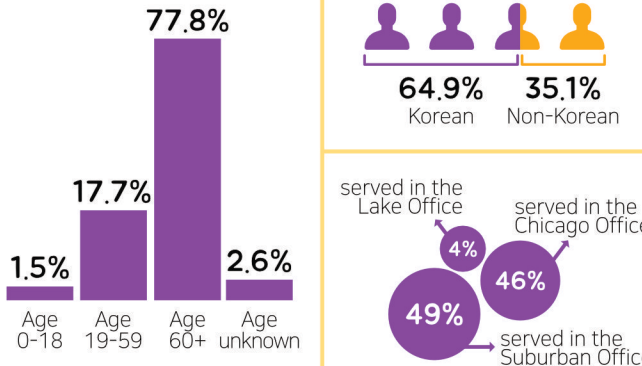

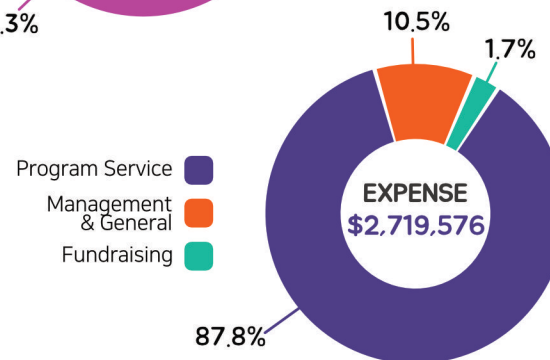
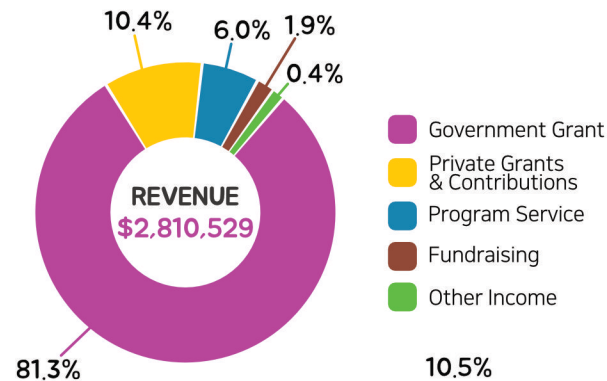
