We offer eligibility counseling and application assistance for the following public benefits:

- **Benefit Access Program (Income-based)**
 - Reduced license plate sticker fee for age 65+ and those with disabilities
- **RTA Free Transit Card (Income-based)**
 - Free transit card for age 65+ and those with disabilities.
- **SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program/LINK Card, formerly Food Stamp)**
 - Government assistance for food purchasing and nutrition needs
- **Government medical benefit programs including Medicaid, Medicaid Spenddown, All Kids & Moms & Babies**
 - Free health insurance for low-income individuals and families of various age.
 - No immigration status requirement for medical benefits for minors under the age of 18 and expecting mothers (All Kids & Moms and Babies)
- **Medicare Part A, Part B, and Part D Enrollment and Consultation**
 - Medicare initial enrollment and consultation
- **Immigrant Family Support Program (IFSP) application**
 - Cash assistance for families not eligible for stimulus check during the COVID pandemic
 - No immigration status required
- **LIHEAP (Low Income Household Energy Assistance Program) Until 8/15/2024**
 - Assistance with heating and electricity bills for Cook County and Lake County residents.
- **Cook County Senior Property Tax freeze and more (income based)**
- **Information on Supplemental Security Income eligibility and applications**
 - Monthly cash assistance for age 60+ and/or those with documented disabilities
- **Senior housing application assistance**
 - Includes pre-application and recertification applications for senior residential communities
