FY24 LIHEAP Applications

The application for the FY24 LIHEAP (Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program) Program begins on **October 2nd, 2023.**

Priority group is back; in October and November, applications are open for the applicants who meet the criteria for corresponding priority groups:

- **Priority Group 1, October 2023:** any households with member(s) of age 60+, or child(ren) under the age 6, or members who have a disability
- **Priority Group 2, November 2023:** Any households that received a utility disconnect notice or had their utilities disconnected
- Priority Group 3, December: All other eligible households may apply

An info session about this year's LIHEAP Program will be held **tomorrow**, August 25th, at the Mount Prospect office (1166 S. Elmhurst Rd., Mt. Prospect, IL 60056). This info session is offered in Korean language only.

Eligibility and documents required: as of 8/14, we are waiting for the most up-to-date information from CEDA. However, we do not expect the income guidelines to change drastically.
