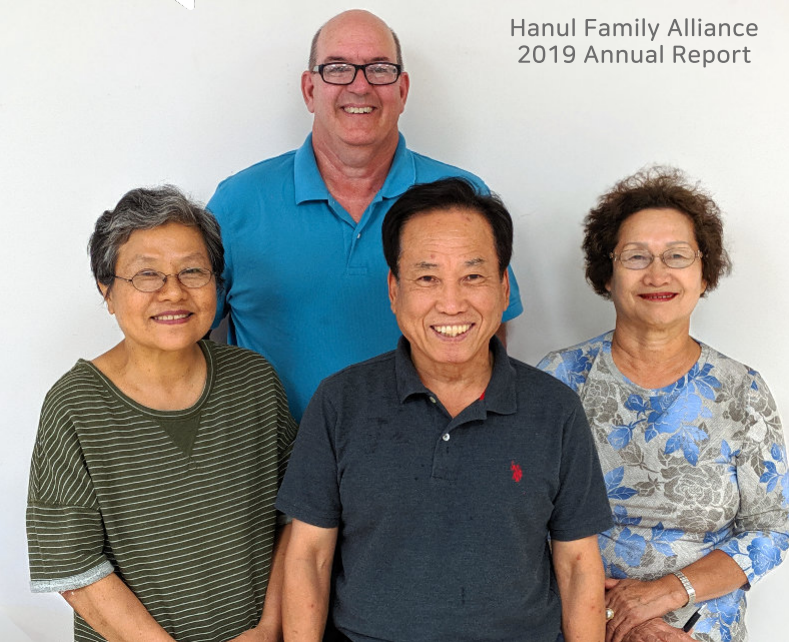

40,000 meals provided by all Hanul offices and home delivered meal program.

Since 2000, Hanul Family Alliance has served senior immigrants and their families with the congregate meal program that serves a hot, homemade Korean meal every day. One Korean-American couple, Mary Lou and Andrew Lee, have been coming to Hanul for 15 years to enjoy healthy meals and good company. "It's a very balanced meal. Andrew has a medical condition where he has to eat every 2 1/2-3 hours. It's hard to fill in everything seven days a week," said Mary Lou. "Hanul adds a big thing to the city by providing the food to a lot of people who really need it." For the Lees, community, acceptance, and openness to making new connections is a continuing theme in their life every time they gather at Hanul.

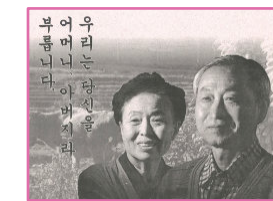

1997
Started as a cultural performance event at Amundsen High School in celebration of Korean Parents' Day in May.



1999
Korean American Dry Cleaners' Association joined as the first major event sponsor and continues to support the event to this day.



2009
Honam Midwest Fellowship Association joined as the second major event sponsor. Senior's Day started being recognized and funded by the Overseas Korean Foundation of the Republic of Korea. Korean Air also became a regular sponsor.

2019
The 19th Annual Celebration was held at Theodore Roosevelt High School. Volunteers' ages ranged from 12 to 78 years old.

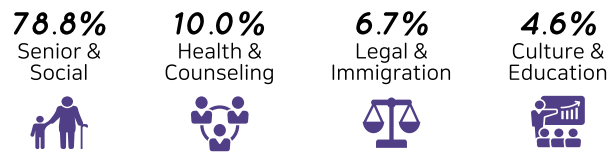

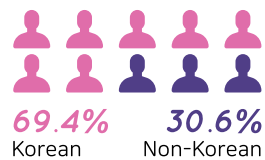

CLIENTS BY DEPARTMENT

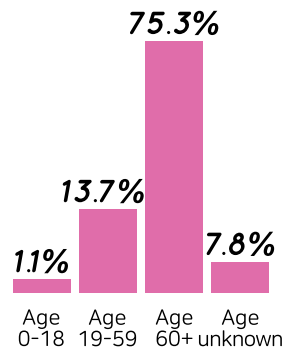


CLIENT ETHNICITY

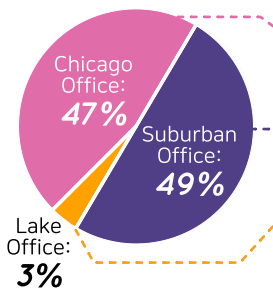
CLIENT AGES



TOP TEN CITIES WHERE OUR CLIENTS LIVE



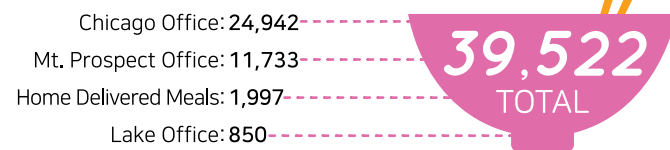

Total number of Home Care clients **377**

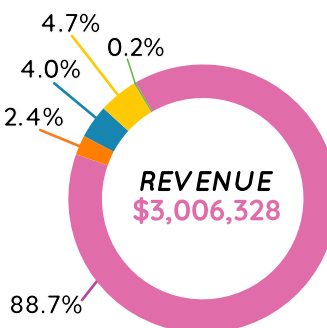
25% of Home Care clients have issues with mobility.

112,809 hrs of services were provided by 110 Home Care Aides.

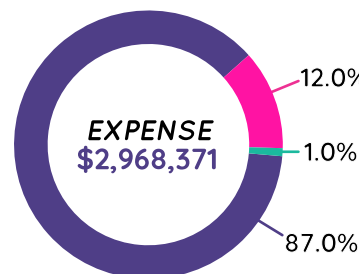
