지금으로부터 30년 전, 미국 복지 시스템에 대한 이해가 부족하고 영어가 불편한 한인 어르신들을 위해 한울종합복지관의 옛 이름 시카고한인노인복지센터가 1987년에 설립되었습니다. 시카고 알바니파크내 컷지길에 위치한 시카고 사무실은 노인아파트에 거주하고 계신 한인 어르신들이 매일 찾는 사랑방의 역할을 수행하고 있습니다.

1999년에 시작된 북부사무소는 시카고 외곽지역으로의 급격한 이민자 인구이동에 따른 다양한 복지 서비스 개발의 필요에 의해 노인복지, 가족지원, 이민, 건강, 문화교육 등 5개의 복지사업이 제공되고 있습니다. 계속 급증하는 레이크 카운티 지역 한인들을 위한 3번째 사무실의 서비스가 2013년 시작됨에 따라, 이제 한울은 시카고 전 지역에서 전문적인 통합복지사업을 수행하는 대표적인 비영리 봉사기관으로 성장했으며, 30년 역사를 교훈 삼아 한인 노인과 가족들의 삶의 질 향상을 위한 효율적이고 효과적인 복지관으로 한단계 도약할 것입니다.

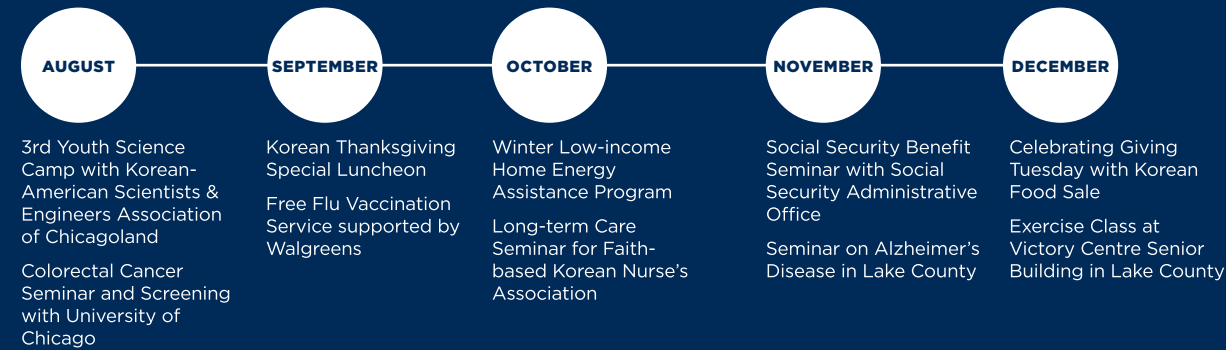

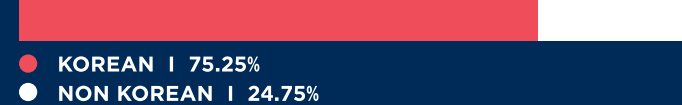
### NUMBER OF SERVED CLIENTS



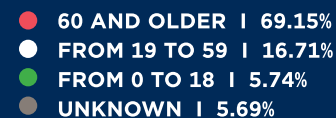
