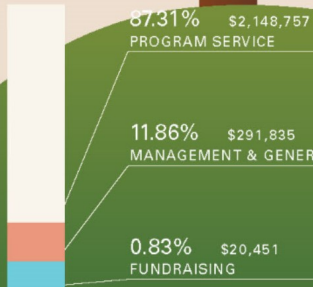

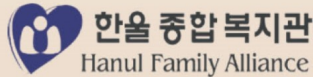

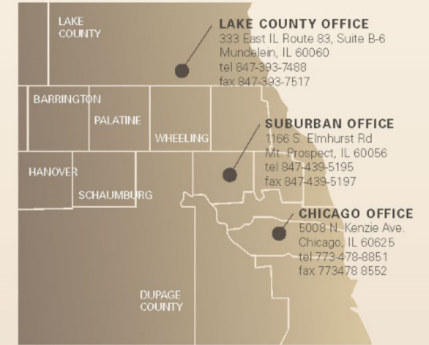
Vision

Hanul Family Alliance Provides comprehensive community-based services to meet the needs of Korean-American seniors and families and enhance their quality of life.

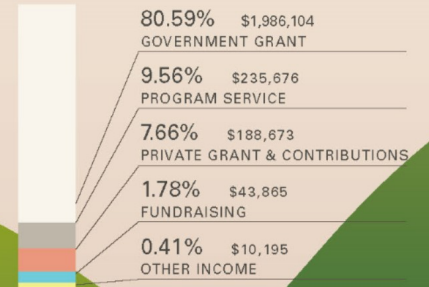
Office Locations

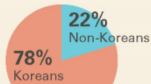

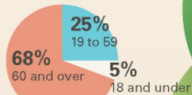

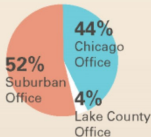
